OPERATION CORPORATEITEM 1. INTELLIGENCE

1. SIR TERENCE LEWIN invited the Deputy Chief of the Defence Staff (Intelligence) to update them on current intelligence.

2. LIEUTENANT GENERAL GLOVER (Deputy Chief of the Defence Staff (Intelligence)) reviewed the intelligence published in the latest summary (1). He gave an assessment of Argentine naval intentions; of Argentine air capability in the light of known losses; and of Argentine perception of the future intentions of our land forces, and their reactions to these. He concluded by saying that reports of Argentine attempts to procure arms from Israel were being investigated and appropriate diplomatic action was being taken.

ITEM 2. OWN FORCES

3. REAR-ADMIRAL BROWN (Assistant Chief of the Defence Staff (Operations)) summarised the deployment and future intentions of the Task Force.

ITEM 3. PUBLIC RELATIONS

4. MR TAYLOR (Chief of Public Relations) reported on Press coverage. He said he would investigate that day whether any further control over live reporting via MARISAT was either feasible or necessary; although the incident involving HMS ANTELOPE had been successfully controlled initially, the news that she had been badly damaged had nevertheless leaked out.

5. In discussion the following points were made:
 - a. The Secretary of State was due to make a statement in the House of Commons that afternoon. The announcement of further details of the previous day's operations should be coordinated with that statement.
 - b. It was intended to publish the names of the casualties of HMS ARDENT that day.
 - c. The timing of an announcement about the accident involving a Sea Harrier from HMS HERMES needed careful consideration; it could not in any event be announced before the next of kin had been informed.
6. Summing up, SIR TERENCE LEWIN invited the Permanent Under Secretary to consult military staffs in the preparation of the draft statement for the Secretary of State, and said that he would wish to see that draft.
